SUPERVISION COVENANT, 2013
(Private Document relating to Supervision)

Supervision is the pastoral practitioner's reflective learning from experience within the context of their ministry/work.

Practitioners may request Individual or Peer Group Supervision with a designated Supervisor. Places and times of meetings are negotiated with the Supervisor.

The Code of Ethics states that Specified Ministers have a responsibility to ensure that they receive regular professional supervision to assist in the maintenance of boundaries in pastoral relationships, quality of ministry, to discuss ongoing situations of conflict and explore opportunities for personal and professional growth.

At a Supervision Session:

- The Supervisee is responsible for the time allocated. (Must inform the Supervisor of cancellation up to 24 hours beforehand of absence otherwise the fee will still stand.)
- The Supervisee normally sets the agenda.
- The Supervisor provides no reports unless it is specifically agreed to at the beginning of the contract.
- The cost is met by the Congregation/Church Council (or other Employing Body), or the Supervisee.
